Leading and working with departmental managers, heads of staff, team leaders, committees, staff and volunteers the successful applicant will have excellent interpersonal and leadership skills and will be responsible for the day to day running of the railway at all levels and across all departments.

This Safety Critical full-time position will be based at the railway's offices in Aviemore and is a permanent position subject to an agreed probationary period.
